## Luminaries Light up Crosswinds!

A big Thank You to the Heenan family for again hosting the luminary assembly!



We have approximately 400 luminary kits which will be displayed this year. The Crosswinds Luminary Lighting is Christmas Eve, December 24<sup>th</sup>. Rain date is December 25<sup>th</sup>.

Each luminary kit contains 10 lbs. of sand to be evenly divided into the 12 white luminary bags. This is approximately 8 oz (1 cup) of sand per bag. Be sure to fold the top of each bag down about one inch to help keep the bag open and sturdy.

Please take care when placing your luminaries, keep them away from any leaf or brush piles, and keep an eye on them as they light up our neighborhood.
